SOFTBALL

Was invented in Chicago, Illinois by George Hancock. It was originally an indoor sport. Although it was known by various different names in the beginning, it finally got its official name of "Softball" in 1926.

SQUASH

Squash was invented 185 years ago by students at the Harrow School outside London. Upper class prisoners in the London debtors' prison, had previously played a similar sport, rackets, which involved hitting a ball against walls to get exercise, according to the World Squash Federation.

The **Titanic** had a squash court and professional **Fred Wright** went down with the ship.

TABLE TENNIS

Table Tennis became a medal Olympic sport in the 1988 Summer Olympics in Seoul. Early Table Tennis paddles were normally made of cork, cardboard or wood, and covered with cloth, leather or sandpaper.

SWIMMING

Swimming started in the 1st century and has been part of the Olympics since 1896.

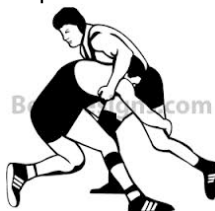
Over 50% of world class swimmers suffer from shoulder pain.
