South African Masters Archery

National Archery Championships will be hosting the 67th SA National Championships at the Marks Park Sports Club, Johannesburg from 27 April to 1 May 2017. This event will be organised following the WORLD ARCHERY rules and the World Championship rules for 2017, in all World Archery and SANAA recognised categories. The championships will comprise of a 1440 round, a 720 round and eliminations and provincial and mixed team events.
